UPDATE

- The Waterfront Garage Sale on April 30th brought in \$170 towards our projects and we received \$2000 from the Town - Grants in Aid. Our funds are in an LDHS bank account for future restoration costs.
- We have done some repairs to the Humdirgen engine parts, cleaned away the blackberries again in the fenced enclosure and removed some gravel from the track leading into the enclosure.
- Repairs are being made to the floor in the old first aid shed
- Scrapped paint from this shed but still more to do
- Had trees and shrubs cut down in track areas
- Advertised our project with signs, photos and slideshow at the Town's Ladysmith Museum Open House on Saturday, June 18, 2016
- Gave an oral progress report at the LDHS Director's meeting on June 21, 2016
